HOW TO HUMBLY RESTORE A RELATIONSHIP
6 steps of humility

1. ASK _____

“God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.” James 4:6b (NIV)

2. AFFIRM _____

“Have a profound respect for each other.” Rom. 12:10b (JB)

“Do not let selfishness or pride be your guide. Instead, be humble and give more honor to others than to yourself.” Phil 2:3 (NCV)

3. ACKNOWLEDGE _____

“Each person must be responsible for himself.” Gal. 6:5 (NCV)

“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.” Rom. 3:23 (NIV)

4. ALLOW _____

“You must make allowance for each other’s faults and forgive the person who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others.” Col. 3:13 (NLT)

5. ADJUST _____

“Look out for one another’s interests, not just your own.” Phil. 2:4 (GN)

“We should please others. If we do what helps them, we will build them up in the Lord.” Rom. 15:2 (NLT)

6. ABANDON _____

“Marriage is not a place to ‘stand up for your rights.’ Marriage is a decision to serve the other...” 1 Cor. 7:4 (Mes)

“Your attitude should be the same as Christ Jesus had. Though He was God, He did not demand and cling to His rights as God... Instead of this, of His own free will, He gave up all He had and took the nature of a servant.” Phil. 2:5-7 (NLT &GN)
